	quality of teaching have produced exemplary standards in	
	writing)	

	Governors agreed that there was no merit in ruing the	
	outcome and that there was still work to be done in	
	improving the quality of teaching and learning	
	MC has already made changes in KS2 with additional	
	support and mentoring.	
	 Chris Newton has been asked to work in Y5 for Nicola 	
	Wright's maternity cover	
	 Other schools have been identified as places to observe good practice 	
	 SC identified reasoning skills as a key focus in improving 	
	mathematics
