Alongside these activities, we would ask you to support your children in taking part in activities that will help them to develop these key values. They will keep a record throughout Year Five that reminds them of their achievements, and we are thinking of new and creative ways to do this throughout the year. The children will share all their hard work and achievements at the Leadership Award Ceremony.

The children are introduced to the Leadership Award, all the values and the activities we have planned, during our first trip to Elterwater, so please don't worry if they seem unsure at the moment!

During the Leadership Award your child will be volunteering their time to help children in school, and the wider community, in a number of different ways. As part of the Award, Year 5 have a residential visit to our friends at Parkinson Lane Primary School, in Halifax. Apart from the cost of the coach, this trip is completely free.

Also this year, your child will be involved in enterprise activities that will involve them raising money through planning and making products and then selling them to buy important equipment. They will use this equipment during their Rydal camping trip.

Outlined on the next page is an overall cost for these opportunities. This cost is payable in instalments throughout the year and you will be given a balance card to help keep track of payments.
